Alvaro Viljoen: Biosketch

Alvaro completed a BSc, BSc Hons. (cum laude) and MSc (cum laude) in Botany at Stellenbosch University (SA). In 1994 he commenced with a PhD at the University of Johannesburg on the chemotaxonomy of the genus *Aloe*. In 1999 he was appointed as lecturer in the School of Pharmacy at WITS Medical School where he was promoted to Associate Professor in 2004. In July 2005 he was offered a research fellow position in the Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Tshwane University of Technology (Pretoria). More than 100 post-graduate students have graduated under his supervision. He has authored / co-authored >320 peer reviewed papers, 2 books and several book chapters mostly on the phytochemical exploration and pharmacological activity of indigenous medicinal and aromatic plants. He has been elected on to the editorial board of Phytochemistry (Elsevier), Journal of Applied Research on Medicinal and Aromatic Plants (Elsevier), and currently he is the Editor-in-Chief of the Journal of Ethnopharmacology (Elsevier, IF 5.4) since 2017. In October 2013 Alvaro was awarded the National Research Chair in Phytomedicine a position which he holds concurrently as Director of the SAMRC Herbal Drugs Research Unit in South Africa.
