

**Angela I. Calderón, Ph.D.** is the Gilliland Endowed Professor in Drug Discovery and Development at Auburn University's Harrison College of Pharmacy. She earned her B.S. in Pharmacy from the University of Panama, and her M.Sc. and Ph.D. in Pharmacognosy from the University of Illinois at Chicago (UIC) and University of Lausanne, respectively. Her postdoctoral research focused on mass spectrometry applications in biomedical sciences at UIC. Dr. Calderón specializes in natural product drug discovery and botanical safety using advanced mass spectrometry. She has published over 70 peer-reviewed articles, holds a U.S. patent, and has received funding from NIH, USP, and industry. She serves on expert panels for the U.S. Pharmacopeia and advisory boards for leading journals in the field of Pharmacognosy.
