

■ Short Biography

Professor Hung-Rong Yen is Dean of the College of Chinese Medicine at China Medical University, and Director of the Division of Integrated Medicine at China Medical University Hospital, Taiwan. A physician-scientist with dual training in Western and Chinese medicine, he is a strong advocate for integrating traditional and modern healthcare. He earned his M.D. from China Medical University, completed clinical training in both disciplines at Chang Gung hospitals, obtained his Ph.D. from Chang Gung University, and undertook a three-year research fellowship in immunology at Johns Hopkins University, USA. His integrative clinical teams have twice received Taiwan's SNQ Award, his research on Taiwan's native herbal medicine earned the Innovation Award from the International Society of Ethnopharmacology (ISE), and his acupuncture research was honored with the Science Award by the International Council of Medical Acupuncture and Related Techniques (ICMART). Recognized among the World's Top 2% Scientists by Scopus for both lifetime and annual research impact, his work spans multiple biomedical disciplines.
